RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach applied lessons to music majors and non-majors, recruitment of qualified students to the Willamette music program.

QUALIFICATIONS: Outstanding and active performer with evidence of successful teaching experience, and a strong desire to motivate students and see students succeed. BA or BM in Music preferred, with comparable professional performing and teaching experience considered.

THE DEPARTMENT: The Willamette University Department of Music has six full-time faculty and twenty part-time faculty. The department annually serves 300-400 students, attracting large numbers who desire quality in music within a liberal arts setting. Willamette offers students intensive professional training in several music areas. Willamette awards four music degrees: Bachelor of Arts in Music, Bachelor of Music degrees in Performance, and Composition. Performance opportunities are available through private instruction and performing ensembles that include University Chamber Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, Chamber Music, Voce Femminile (Women's Choir), Male Ensemble Willamette, Willamette Singers, Chamber Choir, Contemporary Improvisation, and Dramatic Vocal Arts.

THE UNIVERSITY: Willamette University, the first university in the West, is comprised of the College of Liberal Arts which includes a graduate program in teaching, the College of Law, and the Atkinson Graduate School of Management. Willamette has long been known for its intellectual vitality, its cohesive community, its concern for each student, close relationships between students and faculty members, and education which prepares students for successful professional and personal lives. The College of Liberal Arts is selective and seeks serious and talented students. The campus has 40 buildings on 57 acres with a new music hall.
